DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW LOCATION

Driving from south of Nanaimo, follow Hwy 19 as if heading for Campbell River. Turn right at the Northfield Rd. exit. At the first traffic light turn left onto Bowen Rd. Travel through the light at highway 19A (old Island Hwy) and follow around to the back of the Country Club Centre.

If arriving by BC Ferry (Departure Bay), follow the highway directional signs heading north to Parksville. At the junction with Highway 19A, the Country Club Centre is 3.4 km North on your right.

The Nanaimo Gladiolus and Dahlia Society wishes to thank the Country Club Centre for their continued courtesy and support afforded to our club and the shows we stage.

Exhibits may be staged the night before the show (August 28th) from approximately 6 pm to 10 pm. We always wait for the mall to close before placing the entries in their respective sections. Placement of exhibits continues from 7am to 10 am on Saturday morning, August 29th.

The show is open to the public during normal shopping hours and will end at 3:00 pm Sunday August 30th, 2026.

Exhibits should be removed at that time but not earlier.

Any blooms not removed will become the property of the Society. The gladioli and dahlias will be given to people by donation, in the mall at show's end.

Exhibitors should pick up any ribbons they wish to keep at 2:00 pm Sunday, prior to close of the show. Our show officials will retain for you all your ribbons from the Head table at the end of the show. If you wish ribbons from other areas, please notify the Show Chair. A list of your entries showing placement **MUST ACCOMPANY** your request.

GENERAL RULES-DAHLIAS

The show is open to all exhibitors. There is no entry fee.

1. Dahlias will be exhibited according to American.Dahlia.Society. classification. A fault will be assessed for undersized or oversized blooms. Dahlias not listed in the A.D.S. booklet will be shown in the appropriate size, type, and colour class. The Show Chair or any Senior Judge will aid in classifying any new variety or any not named in the classification list and will mark the exhibitor's tag. **A list of any classified blooms not listed in A.D.S. classification book for 2026 (or composite) will need to be submitted to the Show Chair with the name of the originator, year, country introduced and the person entering the blooms including name and address. If this is not done, the blooms will not go into the classification book if they get a blue ribbon.**

2. Exhibitor categories are JUNIOR, NOVICE, AMATEUR, and OPEN COMPETITION. An Exhibitor shall show in Novice for 3 years, Amateur for 3 years, but may advance before the 3 years maximum. Non Head table winners can stay in Novice for up to 10 years.

3. Exhibitors shall obtain a tag from the Show Chair and complete a tag for each exhibit.- example on inside back cover An exhibitor's category is determined by how long he/she has been exhibiting in the shows of any Dahlia Club which is a member of A.D.S.

4. Exhibitors will not require an exhibitor's number.

5. Entry tags MUST BE COMPLETED TOP AND BOTTOM-Please refer to chart at the back of Show Catalog.

6. Dahlias must be shown disbudded and with the first pair of leaves showing above the container. The use of any material above the top of the container to support the dahlia will disqualify the entry.

Containers and styrofoam will be supplied by the society. In the Decorative section, exhibitors shall supply their own baskets and bowls. The society cannot be responsible for damage to personal property.

1. Exhibitors may make as many entries as desired in any one class if each entry is of a different variety.

2. The exhibitor must have grown all blooms shown in the competition, except in the seedling classes.

3. The show committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

4. Judges may withhold an award if entries are unworthy of an award, a second if any entry is unworthy of a first.

5. A bowl is a container having a diameter at the mouth at least equal but usually greater than its height.

Proportion refers to the arrangement of blooms and foliage as related to each other and to the container.

Distinction refers to the overall effect of colour, harmony, artistic values of materials, condition of basket and plant material, and overall neatness. A **Basket** is a container with a handle which may or may not be concealed according to the desired effect. Points should not be taken off if the handle is showing, unless the total effect is marred.

Bowl definition can be found under General Rules at the beginning of the catalogue. Any foliage that is minutely flowered, such as statice, gypsophylia, etc. may be used in basket and bowl classes.

The exhibitor should take care that the foliage and filler material is suitable and does not distract from the display of the blooms.

Artificial supports are not allowed.

Photographs must be 6"x4" mounted but not framed.

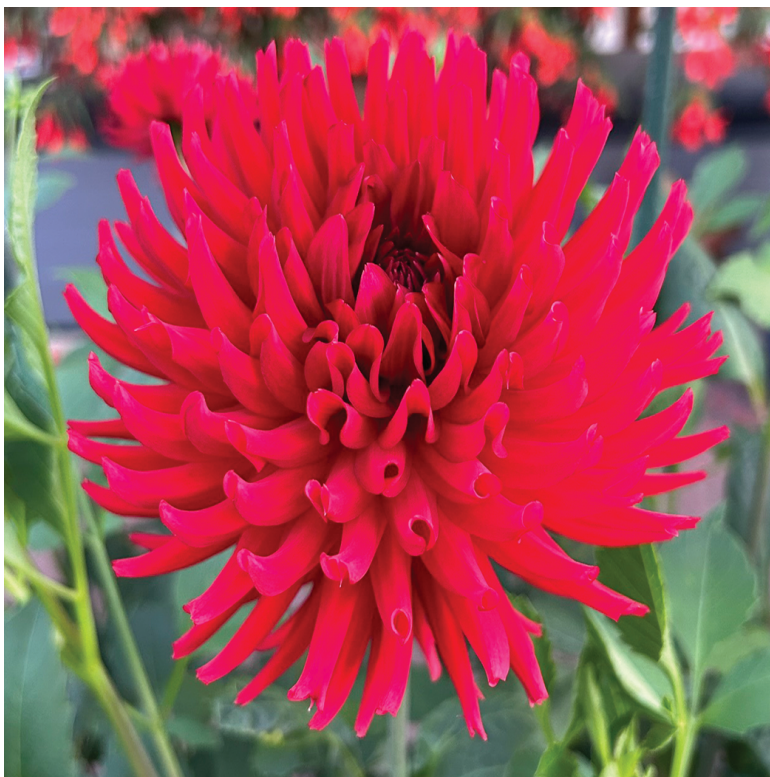

GLADIOLUS



We are excited to have **Gladiolus** introduced once again into our annual show.

The gladiolus spike carries blooms its full length. It is expected for a good show spike that a third at the bottom is in full colour, the next third is showing colour and the last third is not showing colour but has close to the equal amount of flowers to come into bloom. **Each spike is shown with a pair of leaves!**

GENERAL RULES – GLADIOLUS

The show is open to all exhibitors.

1. The 2026 North.American.Gladiolus.Council. classification will be used by the exhibitors in staging the gladiolus entries and is the authority in case of dispute. Where a variety is not listed in the N.A.G.C. classification, the Canadian. Gladiolus.Society. will apply. A classification committee will rule on any blooms unclassified. All blooms must have their complete classification on the tag prior to staging.
2. Exhibitors categories are **NOVICE** and **OPEN**. An exhibitor may show in the **NOVICE** category for three years, but may enter **OPEN** category at any time. The three years as a **NOVICE** includes any show affiliated with the Canadian Gladiolus Society. A professional gardener or commercial grower shall enter in **OPEN** category.
3. Exhibitors shall obtain tags from the Show Chair and indicate the variety and name of every entry on the entry tag provided, including the Basket and Vase Classes.

NOVICE = PINK TAGS
OPEN = WHITE TAGS

4. Flowers shall be shown in containers as supplied by the society, except in Basket and Vase classes for which the exhibitor shall furnish their own containers.

The society cannot be responsible for loss or damage to any container.

5. Exhibitors may make as many entries as they desire in any class, provided the entries are of different varieties.
6. All blooms must be grown by the exhibitor.
7. Glad spikes must be shown with 2 leaves.
8. In sections 1-9 both OPEN & NOVICE, entries must be shown complete with nothing added and nothing removed, except that pollen may have fallen. This must be removed and side shoots must be removed.
9. Stem length should be approximately
400-500mm $\approx$ 20 inches
300mm $\approx$ 18 inches
100-200mm $\approx$ 15 inches

Any significant variation may be penalized at the judges discretion.

10. Use of any material to support the exhibit above the container shall disqualify the entry. This does not refer to vase stuffing or to a peg or wedge.
11. The show committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
12. Judges may withhold an award if entries are unworthy of a first or award a second.
13. A vase is a container having a diameter at the mouth less than the measure of its height.

14. A basket is a decorative, generally flared with a fixed handle, and may be made of woven wicker, metal, paper, paper maché, plastic, crochet, or even lace, with a water proof liner.
